This Agreement is entered into on 6 May 1981 in Ormond Beach, Florida between Joseph Papp, hereinafter referred to as Papp, and Robert J. and Thomas E. Rohner, hereinafter referred to as Rohner.

RECITALS

- 1. Papp has discovered an energy system, which has resulted in the development of an engine on which a patent has recently been filed.
- 2. Rohner has recently completed two production prototype engines which represent the Rohner interpretation of the Papp engine.
- 3. Components of a third production prototype engine which represents the Papp interpretation of the Papp engine is ready to be assembled.
- 4. Papp and Rohner desire the most expeditious and smooth transition from the present situation through the running and testing of the prototypes, through the point where the engines are being produced and sold throughout the country.

AGREEMENTS

In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived hereunder, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Rohner shall give custody to Papp one of the two Rohner engines so that Papp may test, fuel and run it.
- 2. Papp shall give Rohner custody of the Papp engine, which Rohner will then complete to running condition, at which point in time, the Papp engine will be returned to Papp by Rohner.
- 3. In the immediate future, the two Rohner engines and the Papp engine will all be run.
- 4. Rohner will then give one of the two Rohner engines to Papp.
- 5. Rohner will then take his remaining engine, in running condition and with extra fuel, to a location of Rohner's choice where Rohner will have the freedom to experiment as Rohner chooses.
- 6. Rohner agrees not to sell any engines for a period of six months after the first running of a prototype engine unless Papp gives prior permission.
- 7. Rohner agrees that knowledge of the test shall be limited by minimizing the number of personnel who are involved and by requiring each of them to sign a secrecy agreement. This shall cover all testing information including the location of the engines the progress of the testing and the results of the testing. The following personnel are presently allowed to have knowledge: Robert Rohner, Thomas Rohner, John Rohner, Thomas Miller, Dewey Burley, James Monagan, Ernest Engel, Carl Moser, Michael Studley and Joseph Papp. Others may be added with the permission of Papp.

8. Rohner agrees that production personnel need sign secrecy agreements until the patent is issued.
